COURSE PROGRAM

The course offers the possibility to learn, from a direct simulated activity, the steps to complete succesfully a case of zygomatic implantology, from traditional to guided surgery. The participant will learn information about materials available on the market, and the methodology of zygomatic implantology for patients with severe maxillary atrophy. All software for surgical and prosthetic planning will be presented and analyzed. During hands-on session, the participant will perform a case of zygomatic implantology on stereolithographic model based on a case study, analyzing all the steps necessary.
